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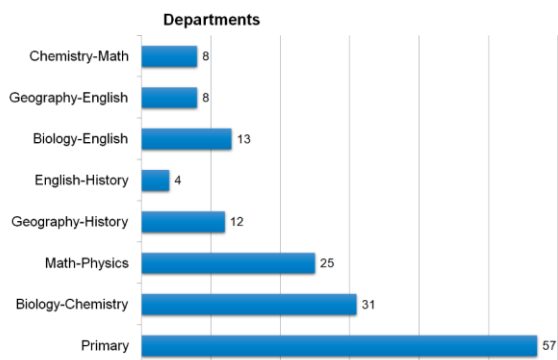

GTEC offered 158 scholarship seats for Diploma in Secondary Education and Diploma in Primary Education in 2020. Every academic year, the college has one intake that takes place in September. This intake, the college has provided scholar for 158 student-teachers through open admission. Students came all nine regions in Puntland and outside of Puntland state territory



About GTEC

Garowe Teacher Education College (GTEC) is a public institution for teacher education governed by a board of directors on behalf of the Ministry of Education, Puntland State of Somalia. The college is legally and officially recognized and endorsed by the regional government. The college was set up in response to the extreme shortage of qualified and well-trained school teachers since the collapse of the central government in 1991. The last cohort of qualified teachers graduated from Lafole College of Education in Mogadishu in the year 1990 for Secondary School teachers and Halane Training Centre in 1985 for Primary School teachers (35 yrs ago), respectively. The establishment of the college was finally enacted in 2004 by the Ministry of Education in Puntland and officially opened in 2005.
